Class #1: Once Upon a Time

Fairy tales, told again and again, boost children's imaginations and creativity, taking them to worlds outside of their own. In this dynamic class, we'll enjoy classic fairy tales for young children and meet marvelous characters who will be springboards for discussions, re-enactments, and make-believe. Problem-solving, critical thinking, and life lessons will be the result! Charting our favorite fairy tales, we'll also learn about the beginning, the middle, and the end of stories. We'll don our crowns and "story starters" will help us make up our very own tales. Artistic experiences will include royal self-portraits and castle art. This class is sure to spark curiosity in our future readers and writers!

Class #2: Count Me In!

Our world is full of numbers - who knew they could be such fun?! We know that children LOVE games, and this class is full of mathematical games that will expand a child's understanding of numbers. We'll use picture books filled with numbers and counting, followed by math games and activities. Class #3: Blocks and Blueprints

Calling all engineers! Does your child enjoy building? This engineering workshop expands on the children's natural curiosity about how the world works. We'll start by exploring shapes and blocks. Then we'll study famous landmarks and create our own masterpieces as well. We'll even create our own blueprints and block city! By asking questions and finding solutions, this hands-on class encourages problem-solving and builds on a child's ability to think critically. Have your child join us in this collaborative class and let's get building!

Class #4: Pick Your Paintbrush

Calling all art lovers! In Pick Your Paintbrush, we'll explore different ways of painting each week. Will it be fingerpainting, painting on bubble wrap, painting with animal feet, painting with ice, or splat painting with pom poms? We'll also be introduced to the color wheel, primary and secondary colors, and what happens when we mix colors just like the mice in the book Mouse Paint. We'll keep those creative hands and minds busy all while strengthening our fine motor skills. Join us as we paint our way into summer!

Class #5: Kensington Kids Club

Stretching, jogging, and touching our toes, we'll get in tune with our bodies and discuss the importance of exercise in this class. From moving like animals to dancing, and building coordination, our Kids Club members will be bursting with information and muscles! Kensington Kids Club offers a fast-paced, fun environment that promotes physical fitness. Come run with me!

Class #6: Icky Sticky

Children love to concoct! What child doesn't enjoy mixing colors or exploring with water, air movement, bubbles, and "what is sticky"? Discovering scientific principles of chemistry and physics all on their own gives children a terrific feeling of success. We'll hypothesize (guess) and will delight in the results! From beginning to end, our experiments will be an exercise in observation and discussion!

Class #7: Digging for Dinos

This is the perfect class for all our budding paleontologists! In Digging For Dinosaurs, we'll focus on what a paleontologist does and what types of tools they use. We'll try our hand at excavating and building our own dinosaur from pasta noodles. We'll discover how big a dinosaur foot really was and use our five senses to describe a volcano. The best part just might be building a fizzing volcano of our own. Step back into the Jurassic Period and explore all things dinosaurs with us!

- Enrichment classes are 45 minutes in length and meet 1:15-2:00pm and 2:15-3:00pm. Classes meet weekly, 5 times per session.
- Tuition for enrichment classes is \$75 a session for each class.
- Enrichment Classes enroll by session. Children must be enrolled for the full five-week session.
- Tuition for enrichment classes will be charged to your Tuition Express account during the first week of the session.
- Enrollment is on a first come, first served basis. Space is limited enroll ASAP!
- A child may not participate in enrichment if his/her account is past due.
- There is no refund for absence for enrichment classes. There is no refund once classes have begun.
- Classes are subject to change or cancelation due to enrollment. Parents will be notified if a class they enrolled their child in is canceled or changed.
- Children must be a current student and have a complete file (up to date file requirements) to take part in enrichment classes. Children must be toilet-trained to attend enrichment classes.
